The Profession of Optometry

Today's optometrist is a vital member of a comprehensive health care team. The optometrist delivers full scope eye care in a variety of practice settings. These range from solo, associate and group modes, as well as interdisciplinary environments such as hospitals and health maintenance organizations. Other opportunities include a career in academics, research or health care administration. All 50 states now authorize optometrists to utilize pharmaceutical agents in the diagnosis of ocular disorders and diseases and authorize optometrists to medically treat eye diseases. All 50 states and the District of Columbia require that licensed optometrists regularly attend continuing education programs for license renewal.

As primary care providers, optometrists offer patients a wide range of services, including diagnosis and management of anomalies of visual functions, diagnosis and participation in the management of various ocular and systemic diseases and the provision of general health screening, education and counseling. Optometric care provides for the maintenance and enhancement of visual efficiency and ocular health which are so important to people of all ages. The profession offers a humanistic, intellectually stimulating and financially secure position as a valued member of the community.

Commencement Speaker

Gary A. Lesher, Ph.D.

Over 35 years, Dr. Lesher has taught more than 5,000 ICO students. Starting as an Assistant Professor of Pharmacology and Toxicology, he retired in 2019 as a full professor and the Assistant Dean for Didactic Education.

Dr. Lesher holds a Ph.D. from Purdue University with a major in Pharmacology and Toxicology.

During his tenure at ICO, he has guided thousands of students through the complexities and nuances of pharmacology helping students understand not just which drug to use for a particular disease but also why these drugs are chosen and how systemic medication can lead to potential ocular complications. Thus, empowering students to think critically about prescribed drugs – especially when the drug of choice is not best for their patient. The skills students have gained from Dr. Lesher's class have been reflected on ICO's NBEO pharmacology scores for decades – invariably ICO students score above the national average.

Dr. Lesher's love of teaching is perhaps also reflected in the many awards he has received at ICO. He has been named Outstanding Faculty of the Year by the Class of 1986, 1990, 2002, 2010, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2019, and 2020. He also received the Trustee's Award for Excellence in Teaching in May 1990. He has served as ICO's Director of Research, as a Faculty Representative for ICO's Board of Trustees and served as Chairman for both the Department of Basic and Health Science and the Faculty Promotions Committee.

Many students will remember the cartoons or use of a drug-related video spoof at the start of class. They may also remember the "Jeopardy" game at the end of the year and the Drug of the Day questions, designed to help review material covered in class.

Most of all, they may remember Dr. Lesher's great passion for the national parks. In Dr. Lesher's classes, students visited each of the national parks one lecture at a time. Interestingly, as current and former students explore these national parks, they often write to Dr. Lesher sharing their experience with him. Since retirement, Dr. Lesher and his wife Lynn have enjoyed time with their family and continue to visit national parks whenever they can.

About the Commencement Ceremony

The pageantry enacted each year on campuses all over the world is the solemn climax and recognition of the graduates' years of study and preparation for responsibility. To help spectators understand the significance of the ceremonies, the following description is furnished.

Procession

The Grand Marshal leads the procession, bearing the ceremonial Mace, emblematic of the authority of the college.

The climax of the processional brings to the platform the Trustees of the college, the Dean, honorary degree recipients, college officers, and finally the President of the college. As his badge of office, ICO's President wears a medallion, emblematic of the history of the college.

Caps

Candidates for degrees wear the regulation cap. Those who already hold doctoral degrees or who are heads of institutions wear gold tassels.

Gowns

The doctor's gown has velvet panels down the front, and voluminous bell-shaped sleeves on which there are three velvet bars. The velvet is usually black, but may be blue for philosophy or green for medicine and optometry.

Hoods

The doctor's hood is easily recognized by the width of the velvet edging, the wide panels at either side, the greater length, and the full exposure of the lining. The hood is also lined with the color of the college or university granting the degree (the holder of a degree granted by Illinois College of Optometry wears a hood lined in blue and white).

The list of hood colors most frequently viewed in ICO's ceremony are: Optometry is seafoam green, Library Science is lemon yellow, Philosophy is dark blue, Social Work is citron, Science or Honorary degree is gold, Arts, Letters, Humanities is white, Education is light blue, Business Administration is drab, Medicine is green, Theology is scarlet, and Law is purple.
